

Calendar Revision Process Timeline



Breaks between terms

- Processing of Registrar reports, transcript roll-over, etc.;
- Need for prerequisites to be met for next course enrollment;
- Not having students miss classes while waiting for grades to roll;
- Financial aid to be processed;
- Student bills to be paid;
- Housing concerns due to delayed processing/appeals for financial aid, etc.

Notes on Image

1. Term lengths vary widely from fall to spring terms (green current/blue proposed);
2. E-campus partial semester course terms end after finals during some terms;
3. Fall 2023 did not officially allow for the day before Thanksgiving as a break;
4. Terms that end after commencement create processing backlogs;
5. The current calendar was a COVID calendar.

Calendar “Terms” Clarified

“Weeks” are the *instructional weeks after* breaks & finals are removed and should not be considered “ordinary calendar weeks” for this situation.

Use of the numeric (ordinary) weeks on the timeline are for visualization of term lengths and assist with calculation of the federally mandated “clock hour” requirements to meet credit hour requirements for accreditation standards (discussed later).

Example:

EKU Fall 2023 is “16 ordinary calendar weeks” long but 1 of those weeks is finals week, and 1 “week” is removed due to days assigned to Labor Day(1), fall break(2), and Thanksgiving (2). This results in a “14 week” academic calendar.

Spring 2024 is “17 ordinary calendar weeks” long but 1 of those weeks is finals week, and 1 week is removed for spring break (5). This results in a “15 week” academic calendar.

The Need for Course Meeting Time Changes


Release of more stringent “clock hour” language to definitions to determine “credit hours” was added back into federal regulations requiring that EKU revisit course times, which are part of the formula for determining compliance with regulations across stakeholders.

Extensive review of EKU course times against the new definition, along with comparison to peer institutions, was conducted prior to calendar drafting.

Range: 2250-2700 minutes = 3 credit hours to meet requirements.

Alignment of terms and addition of necessary breaks result in a slightly shorter number of instructional weeks in the calendar resulted in the need to increase course meeting times.

Other Considerations

Increase the competitive nature of EKU in online learning spaces and bring us more in line with our peers and/or competitors in that recruiting market.

Partial terms aligning with full-terms

This proposal:

- Reduces the “academic calendar” instructional weeks to 14 weeks + finals + breaks (16 *ordinary* weeks)
- Adds **breaks** between all terms (excl. winter and spring)
- Thanksgiving break would *officially* increase from 2 days to 3 days permanently.
- Allows for spacing of new term start dates; final grade submission processes, etc.
- Allows for minimal class time increase (50/75 to 55/80) to meet the federal “clock hour” requirements.
- Balances terms to prevent large discrepancies that can occur due to breaks.
- Prevents finals week from falling the week after Thanksgiving for fall terms.

Registrar Draft of 2025-2030 Academic Calendar

Fall/Spring: 16 weeks (7wk + 7wk + 1wk break + 1 wk. Finals; Winter: 5 weeks; Summer: 12 weeks.

Fall 2025 remains as is with finals after Thanksgiving. Winter 25/26 would be reduced to 5 weeks.

The break between Summer 2030 and Fall 2030 is correct at 3 weeks to account for a late Thanksgiving in 2030.
